



Student Outcomes Focused Governance

Board Guardrail #1

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Board shall not direct or appear to direct staff on day-to-day operations.

Board Guardrail #2

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Board shall not during regularly scheduled board meetings, spend less than 50% of its time progress monitoring the Board's student outcome goals and/or superintendent guardrails.

Board Guardrail #3

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Board shall not deviate from the Board's Operating Procedures.

Board Guardrail #4

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Board shall not negate newly elected members from experiencing a quality onboarding process.

Board Guardrail #5

In attaining the Board's student outcome goals, the Board shall not focus on Inputs and Outputs at the expense of Student Outcomes.
